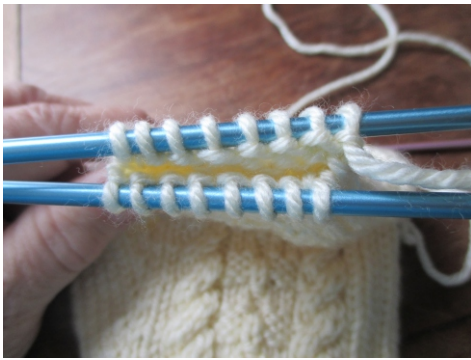


# Grafting



1. Put the stitches to be grafted on two needles. The stitches last knit should be on the back needle, on the right hand side. The yarn will be coming from the stitches on the back needle. Cut the yarn tail to 12" - 15".

2. Front needle: Using a knitting needle or crochet hook, draw the yarn tail through the first loop from the outside to inside. Drop the stitch from the needle.



3. Front needle: draw the yarn tail through the next stitch from the inside to the outside of the stitch. Leave the stitch on the needle.

4. Back needle: Bring the yarn around to the back needle, and draw the yarn tail through the first stitch from the outside to the inside. Drop the stitch from the needle.



5. Back Needle: draw the yarn tail through the next stitch from the inside to the outside of the stitch. Leave the stitch on the needle.

Repeat steps 2 - 5 until no stitches remain. Pull the yarn tail through to the inside of the knit piece. Turn the piece inside out, and anchor the stitch by weaving the yarn tail through the inside stitches. Trim the yarn tail.
